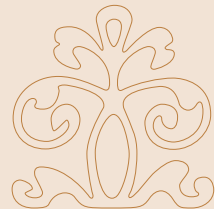

The State Bar of Michigan's Pro Bono Initiative promotes pro bono legal services for low-income persons consistent with the State Bar's Voluntary Pro Bono Standard. The Standard calls on each lawyer to annually provide 30 hours of free representation, handle 3 cases free for low-income persons or donate \$300 for a nonprofit civil legal aid program providing representation for the poor. Firms which meet this standard are recognized in the Circle of Excellence.
