HB 5883**

The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section is not the State Bar of Michigan and the position expressed herein is that of the Elder Law & Disability Rights Section only and not the State Bar of Michigan. The State Bar's position is to support HB 5883.

The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section has a public policy decision-making body with 20 members. On September 7, 2024, the Section adopted its position after a discussion and vote at a scheduled meeting. 19 members voted in favor of the Section's position, 0 members voted against this position, 0 members abstained, 1 member did not vote.
